### **Navigation announcement No. 5/2021.**

Pursuant to Article 14 sec. 1 point 4 of the Act of 20 July 2017 Water Law (consolidated text: Dz.U. [Journal of Laws] of 2021, item 624) and Art. 43, section 6 of the Act of 21 December 2000 on inland navigation (Dz.U. [Journal of Laws] of 2019, item 1568) State Water Holding Polish Waters Regional Water Management Board in Lublin announces that:

On 2 September 2021, the President of the Republic of Poland signed the Ordinance on the introduction of a state of emergency in part of the Podlaskie Voivodeship and part of the Lubelskie Voivodeship for a period of 30 days.

At the same time, on 2 September 2021, the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of 2 September 2021 on restrictions of freedoms and rights in connection with the introduction of a state of emergency entered into force.

- **Due to the introduced legal regulations, we would like to inform you that on the water route of the Bug River at km 217 + 000 - 224 + 200 (right-bank side, Niemirów district, Podlaskie voivodeship, left-bank side, Gnojno district, Lubelskie voivodeship), there are restrictions and restrictions resulting from the above regulations.**

Navigation on the section requires particular care and knowledge of local navigational conditions.
